23-year-olds have set up Tomorrow's Youth International, an organisation aimed to give hope and motivation to a generation of young people.

Beaumont and Williams say the dramatic events in their lives brought them closer together.

"It made us think about what we wanted to do in life but we felt we didn't have all of the life skills that we needed to go out there and do it," says Beaumont.

The pair present a life-skills workshop called Empower U, which they have also taken overseas.

The workshop looks not only at trying to give young people confidence but also real skills, such as personal finances and resumes.

"If you don't show people practical things, they don't see how it applies to their life," Williams says.

The pair work with people from ages 11 to 25 and are starting to organise programs for schools.
